Eligibility:

- Enrolled in a full-time program during the entire award year (2017-2018) at a **member institution of the Environmental Consortium.**
- **Undergraduate students** with Senior standing as of Fall 2017 and **graduate students entering 1st or 2nd year** as of Fall 2017.
- Based on a 4.0 scale, have a current **3.5 GPA** in environmental concentration courses and an **overall minimum 3.0 GPA.**
- Be a **U.S. citizen.**
